

SOUTH STRAND LAKE ROAD VEIWING

July 7, 2008

Met at 6:00 p.m. to view that part South Strand Lake Road where the right of way has been cleared with a road permit from St. Louis County Land Department. Present were Supervisor Terry Nelson, Supervisor Will Deyo, Clerk Sandi Nelson, residents Paulette Warren and Ken Meinke, contractors Dick and Bryan Tracy. Land owner Chris Magney was also present.

Board members, residents and contractors examined and discussed safety concerns along the road. All work done must abide by the road permit obtained from the St. Louis County Land Department. Discussed having the high banks dug out, place in trucks and the fill put in low areas along the right of way of the road. Matting would be placed in some areas to maintain soil erosion. Signs would be placed on the road by the contractor when working. It was suggested to call Ken Meinke when a date is decided and he could inform resident when the working was planned. On the county road permit, the township is given 66 feet right of way, which could make some low areas difficult to work with. Clerk will get information on guardrails. Tracy Excavating will send an estimate to the township.

Chris Magney wanted the Board to look at Evergreen Lane where it intersects with South Strand Lake Road. The intersection needs to be at a right angle and Magney would like the townships help. Chris is developing land off Evergreen Lane and the St. Louis County Planning Department suggested the intersection be addressed. Chris was told he would have to talk to Tracy's as Evergreen Lane was not a township road.
